Church School is a vital part of St. Andrew's Church with 7 classes from ages 3 to Grade

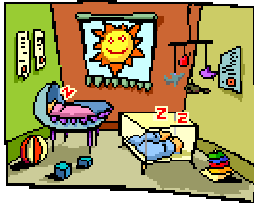

Teachers use various techniques (e.g. guest speakers, inter-class relays, crafts, posters, puzzles, videos, etc.) to present the curriculum; *Rock Solid* and *Seasons of the Spirit* are the curricula that are used. Pupils from grade 2 and above attend communion services. Memory work is encouraged. The Lord's Prayer is repeated each Sunday and an offering is made for St. Andrew's Operating Fund and for Presbyterians Sharing. Pupils support the Canadian Bible Society through the

use of "Dime Cards," "Archie's" wheelchair project by saving can tabs and the Leprosy Mission by saving "used stamps." Each class participates in the annual Christmas Concert. Certificates for participation and attendance are presented in June.

Volunteers, selected and supervised under the authority of the Christian Education Committee, provide loving and personalized care for infants and preschool aged children (up to age 3) in a specially prepared room set apart for their use while adults attend services in the sanctuary. Visitors are encouraged to bring their children to the nursery and they are always welcome.
