9-9:30 a.m. in the church with Holy Communion

10:30 a.m. Service in church (and also on Zoom)

Details about 10:30 am service:

1. Please do not arrive before 10:10 a.m.
2. Wear a non-medical mask.
3. Sanitizing materials at door.
4. We will record your name when you arrive.
5. Seating arrangements will be adjusted to allow for physical distancing; people from the same household do not have to keep physical distance.
6. Ushers will take you to a seat.
7. Ventilation will be increased in the church; several windows will be open so you may want to bring a sweater.
8. Offering: Place your offerings in plate in lobby as you arrive. If you forget, you can place it on plate on piano at the end of the service.
9. There will be no singing of hymns or unison readings/prayers for a few weeks at least. You may wish to read along and/or hum during the hymns.
10. Service will be 40-45 minutes in length.
11. No handshakes and hugs please.
12. At end of service, you can exit by main door or side door (there are 2- one on main level and one at bottom of stairs.)
13. Until further notice, the 10:30 service will also be available on Zoom.
14. Sermon will still be sent out in the afternoon by email.
15. Church School will begin on September 13.
16. No nursery until further notice.
17. Offerings: E-transfer remains as a good method for making your offering; so is Canada Post.
18. 9-9:30 am service – we hope some folk will attend this service so that there will be less pressure on our space at 10:30 . We can accommodate about 55 at any service.

We live in unusual times. Things at our church will be different in order to make our time there safe. Adjustments will be made as we go along. I trust that we will all seek to be patient with one another as we gather in our sanctuary.
